Dear Councilwoman Viagran:

As you are aware, our neighborhood is very concerned with the plans for the Google Fiber Huts scheduled on various locations in the city. The majority of the locations are on residential lots and parks. We are particularly concerned about 175 Kelly, a residential lot, #17 on the Google Fiber Hut Locations list. (Please take notice of the zoning on all of the properties on the list.)

Our Neighborhood Association supports the efforts of the neighborhoods of Haskin Park and West End Park who unfortunately did not receive the support of the City to mandate Google to follow the City systems for building. Their efforts press us to ask why does Google overstep the building processes and we, the annual taxpayers, do not get granted sidestepping Office of Historic Preservation, Planning, Zoning, and Permits. I hope that you will assure our community that we can find other locations other than residential and parks that can house the Google Fiber Huts and that Google and the City follows what was written in the City lease and City building procedures.
